Title of the Practice: Improving Teaching-Learning Process

The Practice:


- The Weaving and Training Cell supplied thread, handloom and monetary contribution to women of nearby villages to weave cloths, gamosa, bag, doormat etc.
- The economic benefits by selling these productions and organizing self financed seminars in the college are invested to pay the salary of trainers of different Add -on courses.

Evidence of Success:

- The list of women involved in handloom, photo of hand over of handmade cloths and signature of women are recorded.
- The cost and benefit of other programmes such as seminar, add on certificate course are recorded.

Problems Encountered and Resource Required:

- Lack of permanent room for weaving, paucity of fund and discontinuation of training of students are problems.
- Permanent room for weaving purpose and more handloom materials are required.
