1. A field study was organized for the honours students of the department to Kaifolansho, an eco-tourism spot of Karbi-Anglong Dist. and Deo-Pahar archaeological site on 16/02 2018. The purpose of this field study was to acquaint the students with the prospect of eco-tourism and the importance of the archaeological remains of medieval Assam.

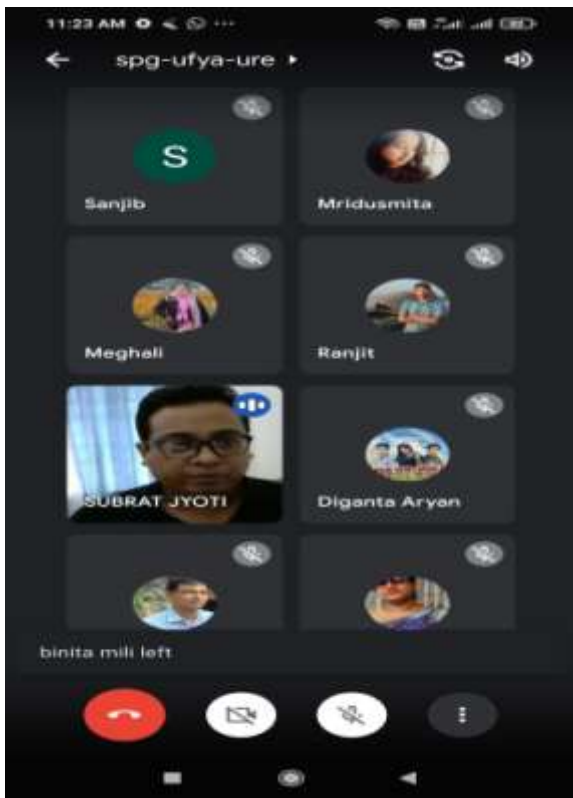
