The coordinator of IOAC Dr. Gitali Saikia defied the objectives of the meeting followed by reading out of the previous meeting of IQAC with due approval of the president. The Co-ordinator of IQAC reflected varied activities of the session and also highlighted steps to be taken for future endeavor in this regard. Teachers discussed on upgrade the present website of the college as soon as possible so that the programmes and activities held in the college can be regularly uploaded. In this regard, the principal sir replied about steps taken by him to upgrade the college website and connectivity problem in the region and action taken by him to smooth functioning of network facility etc. Then, the activities done by seven criterion groups till date are discussed one by one. Mr. Ranjit Khanikar, Assistant Professor suggested to exchange faculty members with nearby college. There were some programmes under 'Moitree- ek gyan jatra' abiyaan before covid 19 pandemic.
