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ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK FOR PARENTS

1.0 Introduction:

Parents are first teacher of children. The support of parents towards education of their children can alleviate the functioning of educational institution. Parents have the responsibility in holistic development of the students. Without their involvement, support, help and guidance in learning, the students get difficulty in advancement of education. The suggestions of parents towards improvement of educationTherefore, feedback from parents of students are collected of Hem Chandra Devgoswami College is collected by IQAC of the college so that the administrative authority can take necessary steps for overall development depending on the responses.

2.0 Objectives of the study:

The objectives of the present study are stated below:

- a) To study the perception of parents of students pursuing Bachelor of Arts in Hem Chandra Dev Goswami College, Nitaipukhuri towards curricular, infrastructure, fee structure, relation of students with teachers and non-teaching staff.
- b) To analyze and assess the responses of parents of students pursuing Bachelor of Arts in Hem Chandra Dev Goswami College, Nitaipukhuri so that the administrative authority can take necessary steps for overall improvement of the college.

3.0 Methodology:

- 3.1 Method: In the study, survey method and descriptive method are used.
- 3.2 Sample of the study: In the study the feedback of 7 numbers of parents of students that are pursuing Bachelor of Arts during 2020-21 academic session are analyzed.

3.3 Tool of the study:

The data are collected from parents through survey conducted by IQAC, Hem Chandra Dev Goswami College, Nitaipukhuri. The survey consists of 5 questions. Each question has alternatives. The parents can choose the most appropriate one. Questions no. 5 is qualitative. The questionnaire is attached in Appendix I.

3.4 Analysis of the study: In the present study, percentage of response in terms of each questions are analyzed by using simple mathematical calculation.

4.0 Limitations of the study:

The limitations of the study are:

- The study covers only parents of students that are pursuing Bachelor of Arts in Hem Chandra Dev Goswami College, Nitaipukhuri.
- b) The study covers only parents of students that are pursuing Bachelor of Arts during 2020-21 academic session.



5.0 Analysis of the responses from parents of HCDG College:


The parents are given to rate different aspects of education. All parents of the sample are cultivator by occupation.

5.1 Analysis on rating by parents on aspects of HCDG College:

The parents are given to rate on 7 aspects of the college viz. curricular, infrastructure, fee structure, teacher-student relation, non-teaching staff-student relation, satisfaction with son/daughter performance and overall rating of the college.

5.1.1 Curricular:


Curriculum plays the vital role in personality development of students. It has been noticing that 37.5% parents replied the curricular as Excellent, 37.5% parents replied it as Very good, 12.5% parents regard it as good and rest of the sampled parents i.e. 12.5% parents thought it was average for their son or daughter read in the college. It indicates that most of the parents are satisfied with existing curricula of B.A. programme of the college. The statistical data regarding the curriculum presently followed in the college are again showed graphically in the following diagram.



5.1.2 Infrastructure:



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5.1.3 Fee structure:



5.1.4 Teacher-student relation:




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between non-teaching staff and students in the college. The data are showed below graphically:



5.1.7 Overall rating of the college:



5.3 Response on Child rearing practice of parents towards education of their children:



5.4 Response on selection of profession by students in future:
